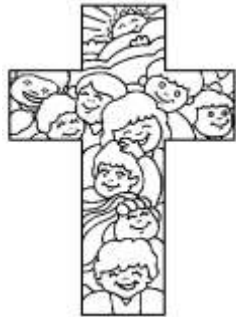
UCC Ice Cream Social
